The investment seeks to maximize total return consistent with the preservation of capital. The fund invests at least 80% of net assets, plus the amount of any borrowings for investment purposes, in bonds. The term "bond" includes any debt or fixed-income security. It may also invest in derivatives such as options, futures contracts, or swap agreements. The fund invests primarily in investment grade debt securities, but may invest up to 10% of total assets in high yield securities. It may invest up to 30% of total assets in securities denominated in foreign currencies, and may invest beyond this limit in U.S. dollar-denominated securities of foreign issuers.

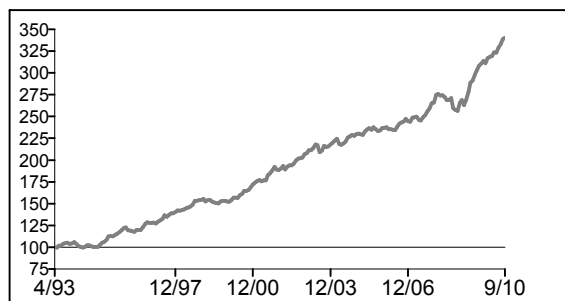
